What is a Neighbourhood Plan?

A Neighbourhood Plan is a planning document that would complement and add to the Local Plan for Huntingdonshire.

Our village plan would enable us to have a shared vision for our community.

Why a Neighbourhood Plan for Hemingford Grey?

Hemingford Grey is a large parish that stretches from the river Great Ouse to beyond the new A14, with nearly 1400 households. It is an attractive parish to live and work in. We all want it to remain so, but we cannot be complacent. A Neighbourhood Plan would provide us with a useful tool that will ensure that the parish continues to be a desirable place to live in, study, work and visit.

It would enable our community to consider and plan the following; green spaces, where and if any development could take place, the appearance and maintenance of the character of the parish, transport issues such as footpaths, cycling and parking, flood protection, drainage, verges, design of new houses and extensions, the need for a new burial site, and community facilities. With the need for all communities to respond to climate change the Neighbourhood Plan provides an opportunity for environmental issues to be at the heart of our parish and its future.

- **Complete the survey** that will be delivered to your door in March telling us what you like and what improvements you would like to see in Hemingford Grey and most importantly what you would like the Parish to be 10 years into the future
