**The A1307 Trunk Road (Little Stukeley to Swavesey,
Cambridgeshire) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic)
Order 2022**

Made

1st August 2022

Coming into force

8th August 2022

National Highways Limited(a) being the traffic authority for the A1307 Trunk Road, and connecting roads in the County of Cambridgeshire is satisfied that traffic should be restricted and prohibited on lengths of that Trunk Road and some of those connecting roads because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

National Highways Limited, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 4(1) and 14(1)(a) and (c) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(b), hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the A1307 Trunk Road (Little Stukeley to Swavesey, Cambridgeshire) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2022 and shall come into force on 8th August 2022 and shall remain in force until 23rd December 2022.

2. In this Order:-

“the A1307” means the A1307 trunk road in the County of Cambridgeshire;

“tip of the nosing” means, as indicated by the markings on the carriageway, the first point where an entry slip or link road joins, or the last point where an exit slip or link road leaves the carriageway;

“the length of carriageway” means the lengths of carriageway described in Schedule 1;

“a connecting road” means the slip roads described in Schedule 2;

“a side road” means any side roads at a junction with a length of carriageway;

“lay-by” means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles, bounded partly by a road marking on the outer edge of that carriageway complying with diagram 1010 in part 4 of Schedule 11 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016(c); and in this definition “carriageway” means any way (other than a cycle track) comprised in the trunk road over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a surface suitable for the exercise of that right;

“a lay-by” means any lay-by adjacent to a length of carriageway and a connecting road;

“central reservation” means that part of the A1307 which separates the eastbound and the westbound carriageways for the safety and guidance of traffic using that road;

“specific A1307 works” means those works not being works of a cyclical nature which are intended to be undertaken on the roads referred to in Schedules 1 and 2 in 2022;

“the works” means the programme of works of a type described in Schedule 3 and consisting of-

- (a) maintenance and renewal works of a cyclical nature; and
- (b) specific A1307 works;

“a works period” means a period of 12 hours starting at 19:00 on Monday 8th August 2022 and at that time on each subsequent day, until Friday 23rd December 2022;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject to articles 9, 10, 11 and 12 no person shall, during a works period cause or permit any vehicle to-

- (a) enter or proceed in a connecting road; or
- (b) enter, proceed, or wait in a lay-by; or
- (c) enter or leave the A1307 at its junction with a side road.

4. Subject to articles 9, 10, 11 and 12, no person shall, during a works period cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the length of carriageway.

5. Subject to articles 9, 10 and 13 no person shall, during a works period drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the length of carriageway or a connecting road.

6. Subject to articles 10 and 13 no person shall, during a works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour on the length of carriageway whilst traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating “convoy working” on that road are displayed.

7. Subject to articles 9 and 10, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to overtake any other moving vehicle in the length of carriageway.

8. Subject to articles 9, 10 and 11 no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed through the gaps in the central reservation located on the length of carriageway.

9. The provisions of articles 3, 4, 5, 7 and 8 shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs of a type prescribed under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and which are appropriate for the restrictions or prohibitions applied by those articles.

10. Nothing in article 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 or 8 shall apply to--

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance or fire and rescue authority purposes; or
- (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable.

11. The provisions of articles 3, 4 and 8 shall not apply to a vehicle being used in connection with the works, for traffic officer purposes or for winter maintenance purposes.

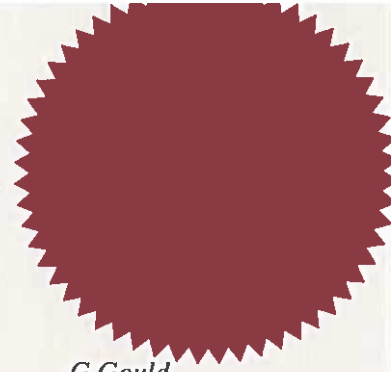
12. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall not apply to a vehicle proceeding in the length of carriageway to or from premises accessible from, and only from, that road.

13. No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
